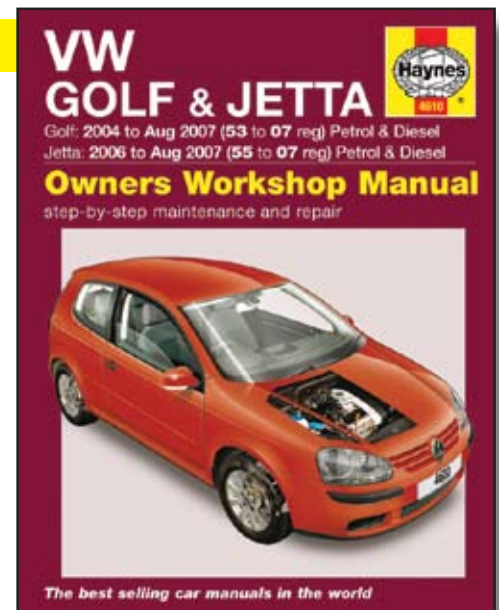

Does not cover 1.6 litre TDi engine.
